Pretty Paws Care Tips:

Ear Cleaning is very important especially when your dog is swimming during the summer. Floppy eared dogs need to have a little more attention to their ears than erect eared dogs. The floppy ears hold moisture. Because of the lack of air flow and the warmth of the body the floppy ear canals can be a perfect place for bacteria to live. If we do not pay attention to the ears by keeping them clean and dry this may lead into ear infections. There are many ear cleaners that can help keep your dog's canals clean and dry.

August Topic of Importance:

Heat Stroke – We have finally had some warm summer days this year. Please be careful with your dog during those hot days. Limit the time your dogs spend outside when the temperatures are hot and the humidity is high. Watch your dogs for any signs of heat related symptoms such as very heavy panting or your dog may be acting like it is drunk by losing its coordination. If you notice anything like this, get your dog cooled down as soon as possible. The belly, chest, and neck areas are the spots you want to apply cool compresses to immediately. Contact your veterinarian asap.
