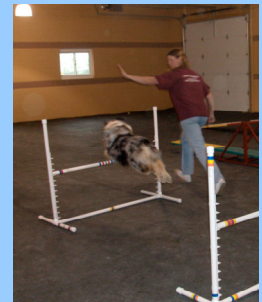

Clip downs and sun exposure**

Upon making the decision to clip down your dog for the summer, please also consider the amount of sun exposure your dog receives.

Dogs can get sunburn as easily as humans can especially when they are used to a heavy, thick coat covering their skin. Please limit your dog's time in direct sunlight. Dawgs in Motion does also have a sunblock that safe for dogs located in our retail store.
