Have you ever known when your animal companion was happy, sad or afraid? Ever wonder how your dog knew you were going for a walk before you picked up the leash or said a word? How your cat knows when it times to go to the vet and suddenly hides? Or even when our pets seem to just know that we are sad or upset and come closer almost in an effort to "comfort" us. The feeling we get from them is more than just the obvious physical clues.

Many people believe animal companions can actually tune into our thoughts and pick up images in our mind and I will show you how. It's simple and easy to do. It is something much more than verbal communication, it's called "telepathy." Telepathy is thoughts or images that we receive in our mind, our 3rd eye or more commonly called the "mind's eye." It can also come in as a strong feeling we get from them deep inside. Animals are non-verbal and "communicate" with us in a number of different ways. Anyone who is fortunate enough to share their life with an animal companion has already experienced this "communication" at one time or another.

We become more programmed to use speech, books, logic and "the facts" that we suppress our telepathic abilities and our creative minds. I will teach you how to rekindle your telepathic abilities through simple exercises and techniques.

This is what the class is all about. Awakening that deep knowing, that inner awareness and that voice within to awaken and connect with the animal kingdom. In this basic class 2 1/2-hour class, you will learn to understand your animal companions and share a deeper connection and bond with them. This class includes discussion, grounding/centering techniques, class readings and meditation exercises to help you explore your abilities as well as to help you more thoroughly connect with your animal companions on another level. September Topic of Importance: Dog Socialization



Monitored, socialization play is very important to your dog. Learning good play manners and getting along with other dogs will help build your dog's confidence and teach them appropriate dog behavior. Pretty Paws care tip:

Nail Clipping is very important for your dog's overall health. Long nails are easily caught on different items which could cause your dog pain and discomfort. Once the nail has been allowed to get too long, the vessel (quick) inside the nail also grows longer. The long quick will tend to bleed when trying to cut the nail short again. If the nails are maintained the quick will also stay back further in the nail which will reduce the chance of it bleeding.
