Pretty Paws Care Tips:

Now that summer is coming to an end and your dog is growing back its coat from the summer cut, it is very important to brush your dog. Know your breed of dog and understand the type of coat it has. Some breeds need daily brushing to prevent matting. Matting can be very uncomfortable and unhealthy for your dog. If your breed is a type that needs regular grooming appointments try to maintain a timely schedule to keep your dog not only looking good but feeling good.

Toxic and Harmful Foods for Dogs

Some human foods can be harmful if ingested by your dog. Chocolate is probably the first thing that comes to mind. Chocolates that contain large amounts of Theobromine are the most dangerous especially if consumed in large amounts. Other foods that may be dangerous are foods or drinks with caffeine in them, onions, garlic, raisins and grapes, macadamia nuts, moldy or spoiled food, yeast dough, sugary foods, raw eggs, potato, rhubarb, and tomato leaves, avocados, broccoli, mushrooms, milk and dairy products, fruit seeds, fruit pits and corn cobs. 
