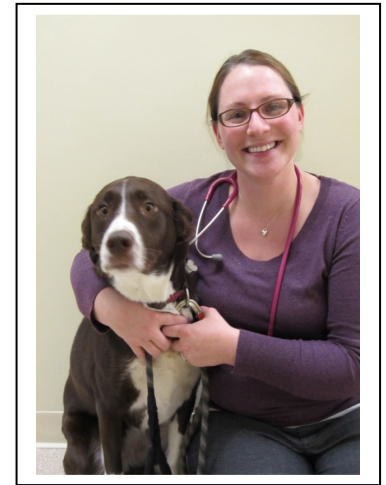
Saukville Vet Clinic

Now that the hustle and bustle of the holidays is behind us, we can start planning this year's events. February is dental awareness month.

Did you know that periodontal disease is the most common disease among dogs? It affects more than 8 out of 10 dogs over 3 years of age.

Preventing periodontal disease begins at home by brushing your dog's teeth on a regular basis. This will help reduce plaque buildup. You need to make sure you use a toothbrush and toothpaste that is specially designed for dogs. You also take your dog to your veterinarian for a professional cleaning under general anesthesia. Cleaning the teeth and the areas under the gum line will help remove plaque and tartar. Possible signs of periodontal disease are bad breath, red or swollen gums, a yellow-brown crust near the gum line, loose or missing teeth, discomfort, or decreased appetite or weight loss due to difficulty chewing. If you schedule a dental with us during the month of February, you will receive \$10.00 off your pets dental. For more information or to schedule an appointment call 262-284-7000. 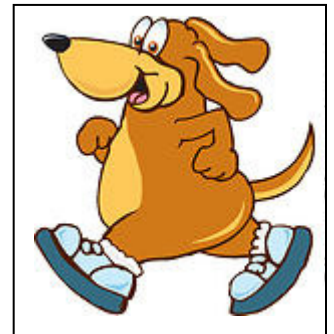

Protect those Paws!!

Winter can be very hard on your dog's paws so try to protect them. You may want to place booties on their paws when they are outside for extended periods of time. Another good product to use is a Paw Rub which also protects the pads from drying out and cracking. Don't forget about the salt that is used in winter. The salt can be very harsh to the pad surface and is also not very good if the dogs ingest it while licking their paws after walking on the salted sidewalks.

Be attentive to your dogs feet and help keep them safe this Wisconsin winter!
