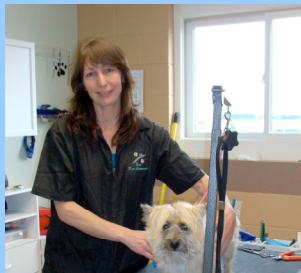

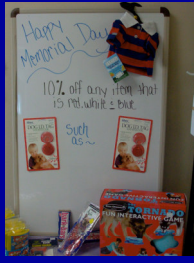

The dog hair is used to attract the oil that is in the water.

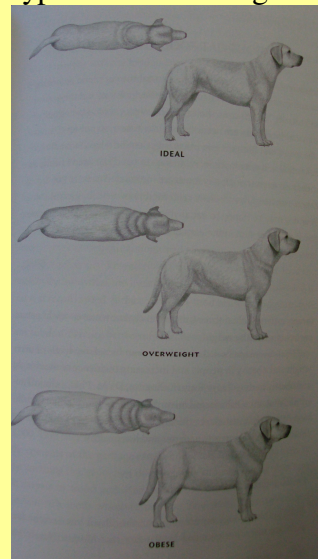
What a good use of dog hair that would normally be disposed of.

### May Topic of Importance:

#### *Weight Control in your dog.*

Are you feeding your dog too much? Does your dog need more exercise? What type of exercise is good for a heavy dog?



Notice the difference in the ideal dog vs. the overweight and obese dogs.

#### **Which does your dog resemble?**

Be sure to check with your Veterinarian to know what amount of food is recommended for your dog. You do not want to over feed your dog. Some dogs do not need as much food as they become older.

Your overweight or obese dog may be at greater risk of injury especially with running or jumping activity. Swimming exercise can be a more beneficial form of exercise in weight reduction because it is non-impact. Also be careful as to what treats and how many you give your dog. This can also be a large component of the weight problem.
